The Following Criteria Must Be Met:

1. Registered Professional Nurse
2. Active member of a professional organization or current board certification in area of specialty
3. Enhances the Nursing profession through leadership and teamwork.
4. Promotes high levels of patient and customer satisfaction.
5. Shows commitment to the community served.
6. Serves as a mentor and professional role model to peers.
7. Encourages a positive work environment.
8. Delivers exemplary direct clinical nursing care to patients and families.
9. Represents PHELPS / Northwell positively at all times.

All criteria must be met in order to be considered for award. If there is any exception, it will be reviewed.

Excellence in Nursing Leadership 2020

This award is designed to acknowledge outstanding leadership on an individual nurse in a leadership position who is in Phelps Hospital Northwell Health.

THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA MUST BE MET:

1. Registered Nurse
2. Employed in a full-time leadership position (Vice President, Director, Clinical Manager, etc.) at Phelps.
3. Demonstrates outstanding leadership qualities and has contributed innovative and effective results for the staff, patients and the organization.
4. Member of a professional organization.
5. Demonstrates a commitment to the nursing profession through leadership in at least three (3) of the following five (5) categories: clinical practice, leadership, education, research and quality improvement activities.
6. Recognized as an accomplished leader at the forefront of innovation in their community of peers and colleagues through awards, publications and other demonstrable achievements.
7. Board Certification (optional)
