Why do we use CHG for bathing?

• CHG bathing has been shown to help reduce the risk of CLABSIs and HAIs

Who should have CHG bathing daily?

• ICU admissions, Central lines: PICC, TLC, Port, Dialysis, PA Line

What does nursing need to do?

- Help identify patients who need CHG bathing
- Obtain a physician's order for CHG bathing for identified patients
 - Some patients will have an order as part of a reflexed order already!
- Bathe patient with CHG wipes daily
- Document daily that CHG bathing was done and indication
