

















In my opinion this is a very personal goal that you do when you feel ready in your career not forced by an employer. Given this recent pandemic, raising small children and working full time it can be difficult to find time to study enough to feel comfortable to take the exam. Its unfortunate that this is the way Phelps treats its employees.

I paid for everything out of pocket and received no support from my unit or management. Other Northwell nurses are paid more for the exact same certification.

The CNOR recertification process has changed recently and is now a bit confusing. A review for initial certification and the re-cert process would be beneficial for the staff. weekend/off work hours class should be offered. Research shows that it is a great incentive for nurses to do the first step for certification. One time free exam upfront should be offered as well since hospital will eventually reimburse it either way once passed. This would eliminate any financial burdens
