Jackie explained they needed \$7,000.00 just for SkillsUSA and that if she gets the grant she would like to implement a Community Service Incentive Program for the students to earn the funds needed by participating in projects coordinated by the instructor. They have to earn 100 hours which will give them a \$5.00 credit per hour. It was also explained that those that don't get the entire 100 their hours will be calculated for activity.
