
ADDED VALUE: GOING DIGITAL

In 2021 we continue to improve our digital platform for a smoother user experience. It will be able to host hybrid or digital contributions from around the world.


At the same time our aim is to create a digital space that provides long-term access to the content of the Berlin Science Week.

Our hopes are high that we will once again be able to meet in person. However, we will keep the added value that digitalization offers.






SUCCESSFUL GLOBAL REACH IN 2020

Join our mission if you are a national or international university, a research institution, a science-based start-up or an innovative business, a science engagement & science policy initiative, or an interdisciplinary science project.

For this year, there are four possible ways to get involved:

Each event receives its own listing and event page in our online programme calendar. It shows all relevant information on content, location, ticket information and speakers.

Digital events can be embedded on the event page if they are livestreamed from YouTube or Vimeo. All other forms of digital events such as webinars can be linked to the session via a prominent button.

ON-SITE



Create your physical event in Berlin at your headquarters, a rented space or in cooperation with a partner – making sure that all measures related to distancing and hygiene are in place.

HYBRID



Add a digital layer (i.e. live stream) to your physical event and make it hybrid.

DIGITAL



Plan a fully digital event, create it from anywhere and with anyone in the world, and become part of the 10-day Berlin Science Week experience.

CAMPUS



On 5/6 November, Berlin Science Week Campus at Museum für Naturkunde Berlin provides spaces for both in-person and hybrid events for organisations who want to showcase their work at a minimum organisational effort.

Participating organisations come from all societal sectors such as academia, industry, non-profits, politics, and culture.




