RE: Parisi - FOIL

Dear Mr. George,

I received your new FOIL request on April 26, 2018, dated April 23, 2018. Per our conversation on April 30, 2018 reflective of my letter dated April 26, 2018; now that the previous FOIL request is paid for and subsequently closed, I will address this request. You are requesting on behalf of your client Thomas J. Parisi *the names and addresses of all persons who were charged (since April 3, 2017) for having a camper over 22 feet long on their premises*. This request is reminiscent of Mr. Parisi's request dated January 31, 2018 where he requests: ***All warnings, appearance tickets, and citations issued since 03 April 2017 for violations of the following Town of Clay Ordinance Codes:***

-§211-29A Parking of certain motor vehicles and trailers prohibited in residential districts.


-§211-29B Parking of certain motor vehicles and trailers prohibited in residential districts.

Because the requested information is maintained alphabetically and not by violation this information is not available. I contacted Robert Freeman the Executive Director of the Committee on Open Government at that time and he agreed §89(3)(a) that it would be like searching for a needle in a haystack. Furthermore, last month when Mr. Freeman spoke at the NYSTCA Conference he reiterated that §87(2)(b) 89(2)(b) authorize an agency to withhold records or portions of

records when disclosure would result in "an unwarranted invasion of privacy".

I hope that this information is helpful and will consider this request satisfied. Thank you.
